

SPORTS CAMP 2020

Dear Parents and Tutors,

Time to think about Sports Camp again!

This year Sports Camp will run from 1:00pm Monday, September 21 to 11:00am Friday, September 25 at the Fairbridge Goldfields Camp School.

Due to COVID-19 restrictions, parents and other family members will not be able to stay at the Camp School with the students and should make their own arrangements for the week. We understand that some parents may want their students to stay with them overnight, due to COVID-19. **Please let me know if this is the case** and if your child/ren will not be attending meals (breakfast is at 7:30am and dinner is at 5:30pm).

When?

- Term 3, Week 10, September 21 – 25;
- Sports Camp starts at 1:00pm in the Gimlet Room. **Please do not come in early to set up dorms. Teachers will aid students to set up after the briefing meeting; and**
- Sports Camp finishes at Fairbridge on the Friday approx. 11:30am.

Where?

- The Year 1 – 6 students stay at the Camp School overnight. Two teachers will be on duty each night. There is no guarantee a male staff member will be on at any given night;
- The Kindy and Pre-Primary students will be finishing the daily program this year at 2:30pm and will **need to be collected from the Camp School at 2:30pm**; and
- Parents/caregivers are responsible for Kindy Pre-Primary accommodation and supervision after the day program finishes.

Costs?

- Kindy and Pre-Primary students - \$60.00
- Year 1 – 6 students - \$75.00

The price per family cost is capped at \$150.00

We would like all students to attend Sports Camp as a part of their curriculum, so please contact to Eloise if there is hardship caused by the cost of this camp.

The school bus and car will be used during the week.

SCHOOL DENTIST:

The School Dentist is available from Tuesday to Thursday afternoons and Friday, September 25th after 11:00am at South Kalgoorlie Primary School. For parents wanting to make bookings for their children, please contact the Dental Clinic directly on 9021 3379.

Please let me know if you and your students are or are not attending Sports Camp by the end of Week 5 (August 21).

ASSEMBLY:

Due to COVID-19 restrictions, the assembly will be held on WebEx on Friday, 18th September. The school dinner we usually hold after assembly has been cancelled.

OTHER DOE COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS

- Students MUST present as healthy on Monday, 21 September at the start of camp. Anyone with cold / flu-like symptoms will not be permitted to attend camp;
- If a student presents with symptoms while on camp, staff will follow Health Department advice, and this may include isolation;
- Parents may be required to collect students at short notice;
- All students must adhere to all hygiene requirements – including washing hands frequently, using hand sanitiser and tying back hair;
- Parent access to the Camp School is restricted;
- Students requiring medication must have a Health Action Plan or school medication form filled in at handover; and
- We will be restricting incursions and excursion venues. We will be using the Camp School, SOTA school building and the Oasis.
